Supply list

- o Cardstock 80 lb 12"x 12" 1 package of 25 sheets
- Chipboard medium/heavy weight 2 sheets 12x12"
- Double sided tape 3/8" and 1/4"
- Wet glue like art glitter glue
- o Patterned paper of your choice, I've used "Sea Dreams" by Stamperia. (1 pack 12x12)

OPTIONAL

Magnets

TOOLS

- Paper trimmer
- Score board / scoring stylus
- o Bone folder
- o Scissors
- o Ruler
- o Pencil
- Craft knife / utility knife
- Optional: envelope punch board

Basic Rules:

- Apply your tape or glue on the indented side (score line) unless specifically stated otherwise.
- Fold on your score line towards the bumpy side of the score line unless specifically stated otherwise.

Cutting guide

Cover:

Cut 2 pieces of chipboard 9" x 7"
Cut 1 pieces of chipboard 9" x 1.25"

Cut 2 pieces of cardstock 12" x 11" to wrap the chipboard

Binding:

Cut 1 piece of cardstock 8.75" x 5.75"

Align the 5.25" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at:

2" | 2-7/8" | 3.75"

Make a score/pencil mark at: 2-3/8" and 3-3/8" (see tutorial part 1)

Waterfall:

** You will need 2 of these elements, the number of pieces is for 1 element **

A: Cut 1 piece 8.75" x 6.25" B: Cut <u>6</u> pieces 6.25" x 6.75"

Align the 6.75" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50"

C: Cut 1 piece 6.25" x 3-1/8"

Align the 3-1/8" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" and 5/8"

Apply tape on the **Bumpy** side

D: Cut 1 piece 7.25" x 3.25"

Align the 7.25" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" and 6.75"

Align the 3.25" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50"

Page:

E: Cut 1 piece 8.75" x 10.50"

Align the 10.50" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 6.25

F: Cut 1 piece 9.75" x 4.75"

Align the 9.75" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" and 9.25"

G: Cut 1 piece 8.75" x 11-1/8"

Align the 11-1/8" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" 5/8" and 6-7/8"

Apply tape on the bumpy side.

H: Cut **2** pieces 9.75" x 2.50" (cut it a slight hair under 2.50")

Align the 9.75" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" and 9.25"

Align the 2.50" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50"

I: Cut 1 piece 9.75" x 3.25"

Align the 9.75" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" and 9.25"

Align the 3.25" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50"

J: Cut 2 pieces 7.25" x 6.50"

Align the 7.25" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" and 6.75"

Align the 6.50" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50"

K: Cut 2 pieces 7.25" x 5"

Align the 7.25" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50" and 6.75"

Align the 5" side along the top of your scoreboard and score at: 0.50"
